If you are a victim of identity theft and you submit or have previously submitted a valid copy of an investigative or incident report or complaint with a law enforcement agency about the unlawful use of your identifying information by another person, no fees will be charged to place a security freeze on your Equifax credit file, temporarily lift the security freeze for a specific period of time, to permanently remove the security freeze from your Equifax credit file, or for a replacement 10 digit PIN.
